Discussed and provided updates on **PLRSC focus activities for 2010**:

- Pine Lake regional water quality study
  - o Cows and Fish update – what can they do to support our initiatives
  - o Presentation by Kelsey from Cows and Fishes. Overview of their work given. They would do Riparian Health Inventory for us at a cost of \$916.00 per site for up to 10 sites or \$861 per site for up to 15 sites.
  - o Discussion followed and it was generally agreed this type of work is worthwhile but not within the scope of our focus at this time. Re-visit in 2011.
- Pine Lake sediment study
  - o Ed tabled the results of soil sample study. Dave to look at the results and have a friend look over them and report back to us. Results to be sent out to the team once Dave has done a review.
- Up stream water quality study
  - o Ed to get water samples for creeks that are running now for testing. Motion to budget of \$2500.00 for water testing by Dave , seconded by Patti.
- In Lake treatment option (Newman Lake study or Lac La Nonne)
  - o Working with Al Sosiak and others, no further update at this time.
- Cattle on waters edge – Colin – next meeting – Colin not at Mar meeting
